The M.Sc. program in agricultural extension

Brief description of the program:

Upon satisfactory completion of the program requirements the student will be awarded the degree of Master of Science in Agricultural Extension.

The program objectives:

1. To graduate specialists in the different areas of agricultural extension.
2. To graduate researchers capable of conducting applied research and providing technical assistance and consultancy for solving problems constraining agricultural extension.

Specializations (if found): Agricultural extension.

Admission requirements:

1. Students with specialization in agricultural extension have to have at least a B.Sc degree with Good overall performance and very good performance in the agricultural extension subjects.
2. Students with specialization in other agricultural specializations have to have at least a B.Sc degree with Good overall performance and to pass certain agricultural extension courses that the department council will determine with very good performance.

The degree requirements:

To satisfactory pass certain graduate courses and write a thesis.

Number of course credits required: 30 credits
